The government's fair price for electricity

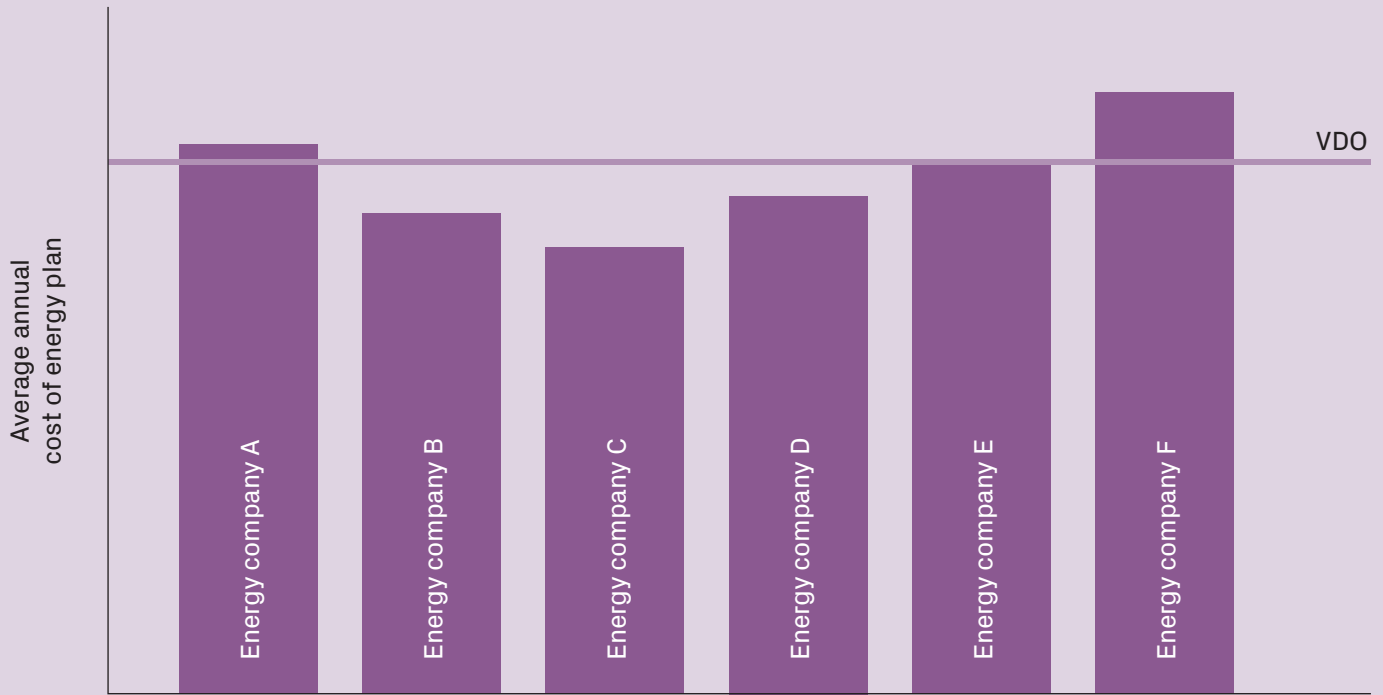
Not everyone wants to shop around to find a cheaper energy plan.

So, the Victorian Government has introduced a fair price for electricity called the Victorian Default Offer (VDO).

The VDO may not be the cheapest plan but it is monitored and set by the government every year to act as a **fair price for electricity**.

The price of the VDO is the same price, no matter which company you buy your electricity from and the quality and reliability of your electricity does not change with the VDO.

If you change energy plans to the VDO, you will stay on this price until you ask to move to a different energy company or a different plan. The government will continue to monitor the price to make sure you pay a fair price for electricity.



If you don't do anything at the end of your existing electricity contract you will automatically be put on to the VDO.

- The VDO is a good choice for people who do not want to 'shop around' to find cheaper electricity prices or talk to their energy company.
